

RESOLUTION No. 815 -2011

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland, a body corporate and politic of the State of Maryland, is authorized to adopt, and from time to time amend, revise, rescind or change provisions of resolutions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to various provisions of the Maryland Annotated Code, the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County is authorized to levy and set the tax rate for several types of taxes in Carroll County; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board to formalize their intentions to require a super majority vote to institute an increase in the types of taxes herein specified.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County will not increase the tax rate for real property, personal property, admissions and amusements, hotels, 911 or income above the rates currently existing as of the date this resolution is executed unless such action is approved by at least four of the five County Commissioners.


This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its execution.




