

RESOLUTION No. 840-2011

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority under § 3-401 of the Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, the Board of County Commissioners is charged with establishing rules and regulations for procurements;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to make sure that procurements are handled in a fair and orderly manner such that all federal, State and local laws are followed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interests of Carroll County to require the use of the federal program known as “E-Verify” sponsored by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to establish compliance with certain federal laws; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to set forth the circumstances under which “E-Verify” will apply to County procurements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that **THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, hereby order and direct on this

14th day of June, 2011:

1. In accordance with the direction of the Board of County Commissioners given on March 3, 2011, the Carroll County Bureau of Purchasing shall begin adding language to all contracts for services that the County enter into requiring vendors and contractors to use the federal “E-Verify” program.


2. In addition, the Carroll County Bureau of Purchasing shall begin adding language to all contracts resulting from County initiated procurements requiring vendors and contractors to use the federal “E-Verify” program.


3. The requirements of this Resolution shall amend and become a part of the existing County Purchasing Policy adopted under Resolution No. 258-92.






