

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The County Commissioners of Carroll County will hold a public hearing on Thursday, February 9, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 311, Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland, 21157, to hear public comments on proposed amendments to Chapter 71, Adequate Public Facilities and Concurrency Management. Specifically, the proposed amendments would **a)** specify that § 71-3B does not apply to attached and detached accessory dwellings; **b)** revise the reporting method of fire/emergency medical services' late and no responses from a quarterly basis to a 24 month basis, updated monthly, in §§ 71-5D(1)(c)[1]; 71-5D(2)(c)[1], and 71-5D(3)(c)[1]; **c)** remove as a reporting requirement from the residential development database a list of County and State road segments and intersections with a level of service D, E, or F from § 71-7A; **d)** remove as reporting requirements from the annual concurrency management report fiscal information and evaluations of adequacy threshold of 1.5 officers per 1,000 citizens for police services in § 71-7B.

The Commissioners may make amendments to the proposed ordinance based upon the comments received at the hearing and may do so without further hearing. Therefore, it is important for interested persons to be present.
