

## NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, February 25, 2010, the County Commissioners of Carroll County adopted Ordinance No. 2010-01 after receiving comments at a public hearing held on Thursday, February 4, 2010. Ordinance No. 2010-01 amends Chapter 97, Construction Codes by adopting the current version of applicable national and international construction codes, renumbers sections in accordance with those applicable construction codes, clarifies the existing permitting process for farm buildings, requires fire resistance walls between tenant spaces in commercial non-sprinklered buildings, clarifies the existing sprinkler requirements for one and two-family dwellings, clarifies the electrical requirements for fire alarm and burglar alarm systems, requires copper conductors in unpaved areas where structural reinforcing steel is not available, requires temporary safety fences around in-ground pools until a permanent fence is installed, adds specifications for multiple well systems, and deletes provisions for privies and sewage waste haulers as they are now regulated in the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR). Ordinance No. 2010-01 will take effect on July 1, 2010.
