

Overview of Public Works CIP

The Public Works FY 14–19 CIP includes two separate sections: Roads and Bridges.

Approximately \$81 million is included in the FY 14-19 CIP to maintain roads throughout the County. Approximately thirty percent (or 280 miles) of the County's road network are considered mainline or collector and arterial roads. These roads typically carry a higher traffic volume. Seventy percent (or 620 miles) are lower volume roadways, including neighborhood roads. Typical repair strategies include: patching, overlay, mill and overlay, full depth reclamation and reconstruction.

The recommendation also includes ongoing bridge maintenance and replacement for three bridges.
