**DECISION**

On July 13, 2011, the Board of License Commissioners for Carroll County (hereinafter the Board) convened to hear Case No. 5603, the application of Sharleen Kutrumbis and Jessica Windsor for the use of Plaza Beer & Wine, LLC for the transfer of the existing Class D – Beer & Wine License issued to Nick Kutrumbis and Sharleen Kutrumbis for the use of Kutrumbis Wine Store, LLC, t/a 1311 Beer & Wine, 1311 Main Street, Mt. Airy, MD 21771, in Election District 13.

Applicant Sharleen Kutrumbis testified she has resided in Carroll County for 5 years and will remain on the license as the resident licensee. She and her husband have operated the business for 2-1/2 years (with no violations) and are now selling the business but she will maintain 20% ownership interest. There is currently one (1) fulltime manager and three (3) part time employees. Mrs. Kutrumbis will oversee the business to ensure proper management but will continue her employment as part owner of a real estate company in Germantown. Her residence is four (4) miles from the store.

Applicant Jessica Windsor is employed by the Illiano Group that is located in the same building as 1311 Beer & Wine. Ms. Windsor resides in Fredrick County and she will be 20% owner of this business. All employees will remain and are currently TAM/BEST certified. Ms. Windsor will assume additional duties to her regular job. The addition of specialty beers will increase business at this location. Ms. Windsor is expecting the closing of this transfer to occur within ten (10) days from the Board’s decision. She addressed the Board’s concern about her MVA record.

Several witnesses testified as to the good character of the Applicants.
