

BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

Basic Legislative Authority

Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition as Amended) titled Alcoholic Beverages, sets out the establishment, scope and authority of the Board of License Commissioners.

Power and Duties

The Board of License Commissioners regulates and controls all matters pertaining to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County. The members of the Board are civil officers for Carroll County. The Board passes on and issues licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages; processes renewal and transfer of licenses; revokes or suspends licenses for any cause which, in the judgment of the Board, shall be necessary to promote peace or safety of the community; and inspects all licensed premises for operation, general conduct and compliance with statutes.

Organizational Structure and Meeting Requirements

The Board has three members who are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County. The Chairman of such Board also is designated by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board meets at least once a month. They shall serve a term of three years.
