APPEALS FROM REFUSAL OF LICENSE

Any person, firm or corporation may appeal a decision of Carroll County in the refusal of a license; such appeal shall be filed in writing to the County Commissioners of Carroll County within 30 days of the date of refusal stating the grounds thereof. The appeal will be considered by a Board of Arbitration consisting of one person selected by the person appealing, one person selected by Carroll County knowledgeable in the electrical business, and one person from a list of qualified arbitrators recommended by the Carroll County Electrical Board.
