

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS
CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND
MINUTES**

On November 10, 2010, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Romeo Valianti and David Grayson were present as well as Tim Burke, Counsel to the Board; and Nancy David.

From 10:10 a.m. to 11:50 a.m., the Board addressed the following official business:

1. The minutes from October 13, 2010, was approved upon a motion of Mr. Grayson and seconded by Mr. Valianti.
2. A letter from Christopher McManus, of The County Cork Pub, requesting the upgrade of his previously approved (September 8) request for a Class B to a Class BR license was presented and approved upon a motion of Mr. Grayson and seconded by Mr. Valianti.
3. A follow-up discussion on the budget numbers representing the cost of the Liquor Board operation provided by Steve Powell resulted in requesting line by line justification for each entry.
4. The Board requested that Inspector Kaizer work on legislation to increase fees of liquor licenses and also obtain information on hearing fees when Licensees are required to appear at a violation hearing.
