

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS
CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND
MINUTES**

On May 11, 2011, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Romeo Valianti and David Grayson were present as well as Jon Scruggs (first case only), Tim Burke, Counsel to the Board; and Nancy David.

10:05 a.m. to 10:40 a.m., Case 5589, Application of Teresa L. Reiter for a Class B – Beer and Wine License (7 Day) for the use of TLO Ventures, LLC, t/a Terri's, 245 South Main Street, Mt. Airy, in Election District 13. Upon motion of Grayson, seconded by Mr. Valianti, the Board found the applicant to be a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license and approved the application as submitted.

11:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m., Case 5591, Application of Kevin Burns and Amber Himes for a Class B – Beer, Wine and Liquor License for the use of Panorama Ristorante, LLC, t/a New York J&P Pizza, Eldersburg, 6252 Sykesville Road, Eldersburg, in Election District 5. Upon motion of Mr. Grayson, seconded by Mr. Valianti, the Board found the applicants to be fit and proper persons to hold an alcoholic beverage license and approved the application as submitted.

From 11:55 a.m. to 1:15 p.m., the Board addressed the following official business:

1. The minutes from the April 13, 2011, meeting of the Board was approved upon a motion of Mr. Valianti and seconded by Mr. Grayson.
2. A letter and drawing from Bill Woodward, of the United Coon Hunters Association, requesting permission to place a permanent outdoor area on the parking lot to serve alcoholic beverages was presented. Inspector Kaizer suggested they contact the Fire Marshall about accessibility issues. Board approval will be based upon the Fire Marshall's report.
3. A one-day liquor license application with drawing from the Mt. Airy Rotary Club for an outdoor event (Music Festival) on August 27 was presented and approved by the Board.
4. A letter from Christopher McManus, of The County Cork Pub, informing the Board of a change in ownership (50% partner) was presented to the Board.
5. A letter from Timothy Brandenburg, of the Crossroads Inn, informing the Board of a change in their hours of operation was presented.
6. A letter from Albert Angell, of the Monocacy Valley V.F.W. Post 6918, informing the Board of a change in their hours of operation was presented.
7. A fax from Ridia Dearie, of the Cork & Bottle Spirit Shop, requesting permission to serve wine outdoors on May 15 was presented and approved by the Board.
8. The Board was informed that two applications for a Class A liquor license had been received and only one opening was available. After discussion, the Board agreed to

schedule a hearing for each application next month.

9. Inspector Kaizer discussed the need for some changes and updates to the Rules and Regulations. A discussion will be held next month on some possible changes. This will be advertised with the Agenda for the June meeting.
10. Chairman Valianti stated that upon his term expiration, Roland Meerdter is to sign the timecards for the office staff.
11. Inspector Kaizer presented an update on the Spring M.A.L.A. Meeting he attended in Ocean City.
