

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

**On July 13, 2011, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Roland Meerdter, David Grayson and Robert Tabler were present as well as John Scruggs, Counsel to the Board; and Nancy David.**

10:00 a.m. to 10:05 a.m., Don Sealing, Clerk of the Circuit Court, appeared to administer the Oath of Office for new member Robert Tabler and Roland Meerdter as Chairman of the Board of License Commissioners.

10:05 a.m. to 10:20 a.m., Case 5602, Application of Todd Himes to replace Anne Marie Johnson-Kellington on the existing Class B – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Leonardo Sauro and Anne Marie Johnson-Kellington for the use of Mt. Airy Inn, LLC, t/a Mt. Airy INN, 1401 S. Main Street, Mt. Airy, in Election District 13.

Upon motion of Mr. Grayson, seconded by Mr. Tabler, the Board found the applicant to be a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license and approved the request.

11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Case 5603, Application of Sharleen Kutrumbis and Jessica Windsor for the use of Plaza Beer & Wine, LLC, for the transfer of the existing Class D – Beer and Wine License issued to Nick Kutrumbis and Sharleen Kutrumbis for the use of Kutrumbis Wine Store, LLC, t/a 1311 Beer & Wine, 1311 Main Street, #104, Mt. Airy, in Election District 13.

Upon motion of Mr. Tabler, seconded by Mr. Grayson, the Board found the applicants to be fit and proper persons to hold an alcoholic beverage license and approved the request for a transfer.

11:35 a.m. to 12:55 p.m., the Board addressed the following official business:

1. The minutes from the June 8, 2011, meeting of the Board was approved upon a motion of Mr. Grayson and seconded by Mr. Meerdter.
2. A one-day liquor license application for the Carroll County Farm Dinner to be held outdoors at the Finksburg Library on September 10, was presented and approved by the Board.
3. A fax and sketch from Terri Reiter, of Terri's Café and Bakery, requesting permission for an outdoor patio area, was presented and approved by the Board. An update to the hours of operation for that establishment was also presented and noted.
4. An email from Osaka Japanese Steakhouse, informing the Board of a change in their hours of operation, was presented and noted.
5. A letter from Vince Dell, Commander of the Westminster American Legion, informing the Board of a change of names on their current liquor license was presented.
6. An email from Ken Lurie, of Bud's at Silver Run, requesting permission to serve alcoholic beverages on their parking lot for an outdoor event on August 5, was presented and approved by the Board. A change in their summer hours of operation

was also presented and noted.

7. A letter and drawing from Scott McGee, of Lineboro Village Inn, requesting permission to serve alcoholic beverages in a secured area of the yard and parking lot for an outdoor fundraising event on July 17, was presented and approved by the Board.
8. A request from the County Attorney for proposals for the 2012 Legislative Session was presented and discussed. Mr. Tabler supported a proposal to raise licensing fees. Attorney John Scruggs will talk with Attorney Burke to recover the proposals made in 2008.
9. Rules & Regulations – The Board agreed to advertise the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations for discussion at the September meeting.
10. Inspector Kaizer informed the Board of a Westminster City Police Report he received regarding Johansson's and a U Tube video. The link to the video was provided to each Board member for their review prior to the next meeting.
11. A letter from Gary & Dell's Crabhouse, requesting permission to close for their annual vacation and general renovations from December 25 – February 7, 2012, was presented and approved by the Board.
