

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS  
CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND  
MINUTES**

**On April 11, 2012, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 311 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Roland Meerdter, David Grayson and Robert Tabler were present as well as County Attorney Timothy Burke, Tim Dixon, Counsel to the Board; and Nancy David.**

**10:07 a.m. to 10:50 a.m.,** Case 5631, Class B - Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Augusto Illiano for the use of Illiano's J&P – Westminster, LLC, t/a Illiano's J&P Restaurant, 480 Meadow Creek Drive, Suite A, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Consumption of Alcohol While Working)  
The Board found the Licensee guilty and issued a fine of \$600.00, suspended \$200.00, \$400.00 payable within 30 days of the written decision.

**11:00 a.m. to 11:20 a.m.,** Case 5633, Class A – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Atul Patel for the use of Patel Enterprises, Inc., t/a The Carriage House, 113 West Main Street, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Sale to a Minor)  
The Board found the Licensee guilty and issued a fine of \$800.00, suspended \$500.00, \$300.00 payable with 30 days of the written decision.

**11:30 a.m. to 12:05 p.m.,** Case 5634, Class A – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Wayne A. Glover and Wayne A. Dyke for the use of Read's Inc., t/a Rite Aid Liquors, #7 Westminster Shopping Center, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Sale to a Minor)  
The Board found the Licensees guilty and issued a fine of \$2,000.00, suspended \$1,000.00, \$1,000.00 payable with 30 days of the written decision.

**1:30 p.m. to 4:40 p.m.,** Remand of the Circuit Court for Carroll County, IN THE MATTER OF: JOHN H. SERRA, Case No. 06-C-11-058737. (t/a Rafael's). Consideration of dates for outdoor events at Rafael's, 32 West Main Street, Westminster, for 2012.  
The Board denied the request for outdoor events for 2012 by a 2-1 vote (Tabler). The Board also denied the request for a stay by a 3-0 vote.

12:05 p.m. to 12:50 p.m., the Board addressed the following official business:

1. The minutes from the March 14, 2012, meeting of the Board was approved upon a motion of Mr. Meerdter and seconded by Mr. Grayson.
2. A one-day liquor license application from the St. Andrews Society of Mid-Maryland for an outdoor event (Celtic Festival) on May 12 at the Mt. Airy VFD carnival grounds was presented and approved by the Board.
3. Anna Canon, of Belisimo's, appeared to request permission to serve alcoholic beverages at an outdoor event on their parking lot on May 5. She explained that this event would be the same setup as used last year and is a fundraiser for the Humane Society. Inspector Kaizer stated there have been no problems in the past and the Board approved the request.

4. A letter from Joseph Tayman, of the Hampstead American Legion, requesting permission to serve alcoholic beverages at an outdoor event (Spring Fling) on April 28 was presented and approved by the Board.
5. A proposed revised floor plan for the New Sunset Inn in Hampstead was presented and approved by the Board.
6. A revised floor plan for the New York J&P Pizza/Taylorsville, was presented and approved by the Board.
7. Changes/concerns to existing licenses during the annual renewal process included:
  - Olde Town Restaurant downgraded to a Class B - B&W (6 day) license
  - Bud's at Silver Run downgraded to a Class B – BWL license
  - Ernie's – annual food sales were reported at 38% (41% required)
  - The Stables – unable to locate one of the Licensees to sign the application
  - Café Tuscany – did not renew their license
8. Evangelos (Van) Sidou, Attorney representing The Stables, appeared before the Board to discuss the situation of not being able to locate one of the existing Licensees in order for him to sign the renewal application. He is going to Circuit Court to file an Order to be able to file the application without the required signature in order to keep the license active. The Order was received and the license was issued on April 26.
