

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS
CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND
MINUTES**

On September 12, 2012, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Roland Meerdter, Chairman, Robert Tabler and David Brauning were present as well as Assistant County Attorney Tim Dixon, Counsel to the Board; and Nancy David.

10:05 a.m. to 10:45 a.m., Case 5664, Application of Henry E. Ruhlman for a Class D – Beer License for Ruhlman Brewery LLC, 2300 Harvey Gummel Road, Hampstead, in Election District 6.

Upon motion of Mr. Brauning, seconded by Mr. Tabler, the Board approved the application as presented.

10:55 a.m. to 11:20 a.m., Case 5665, Application of MacKenzie Kantruss and Joseph Livingood for the use of Challedon Beverage, LLC, for the transfer of the existing Class C – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to MacKenzie Kantruss, Bret Shiflett and Paul Mauk for the use of TGP F&B Maryland, LLC, t/a The Links at Challedon Golf Club, 6166 Challedon Circle, Mt. Airy, in Election District 13.

Upon motion of Mr. Tabler, seconded by Mr. Brauning, the Board approved the application as presented.

11:30 a.m. to 12:05 p.m., Case 5666, Application of Michele S. Pasta and Amy L. Fields for the transfer of location of the existing Class B – Beer, Wine and Liquor License for the use of For My Kids, Inc., t/a Legends Café, 532 Baltimore Blvd., to 400 N. Center Street, Westminster, in Election District 7.

Upon motion of Mr. Brauning, seconded by Mr. Tabler, the Board approved the application as presented.

12:05 p.m. to 1:10 p.m., the Board addressed the following official business:

1. The minutes from the August 22, 2012, meeting of the Board was approved upon a motion of Mr. Tabler and seconded by Mr. Brauning.
2. An application for a catering supplement to the existing Class BR-BWL license issued to County Cork Pub was presented and approved by the Board.
3. A letter from David Gould, of American Claims, regarding LaFiesta Mexican Restaurant settlement was presented. A re-opening date of October 15 is planned. Upon motion of Mr. Tabler, seconded by Mr. Brauning, the Board stated if they are not opened by that date, the license will be revoked.
4. One-day liquor license applications (3) with drawings for outdoor events from the Mt. Airy Main Street Assoc. on October 13; Sykesville-Freedom VFD on October 13; ICARE (Int'l Cancer Alliance) on October 13, were presented and approved by the Board.
5. A letter and drawing from Miia Illiano, of the Mt. Airy Greene Turtle, requesting permission to serve alcoholic beverages outdoors on October 13, was presented and approved by the Board.
6. A letter from Gerald Brandon, of the Whiskey Basket, informing the Board of closing for vacation from September 14 – 24, was presented to the Board.
7. Complimentary Wine Festival tickets were distributed to the Board members.

8. A discussion about changing the Rules and Regulations concerning the 40 hour per week requirement (Rule #57) for Class D licenses was held regarding the earlier hearing for Ruhlman Brewery. After the meeting the Applicant was contacted and will make arrangements to meet the accommodation requirement of 40 hours per week.
9. A discussion about the signage at VCP, formerly New York J&P Pizza at 2600 Liberty Road, was held and it was decided that the Inspector will let them know that all signage should reflect their new name by September 30. Upon motion of Mr. Tabler, seconded by Mr. Brauning, the Board directed the Inspector to issue a violation if all signage isn't changed by September 30.
10. A discussion of age compliance checks and who to use as under age persons was held. Chairman Meerdter will talk to the Sheriff about possible candidates for this task.
11. Legislation will be requested once again to increase the license fees for Class A and Class D licenses.
