

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

On August 14, 2013, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Roland Meerdter, Chairman, Robert Tabler and David Brauning were present as well as Assistant County Attorney Timothy Dixon and Nancy David.

10:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., Case 5719, Application of Robert Prunty to replace Christine Kratzke on the existing Class B- Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Robert R. Baldini, Christine M. Kratzke and Alexander D. Obriecht for the use of Ruby Tuesday, Inc., t/a Ruby Tuesday, 210 Malcolm Drive, Westminster, in Election District 7.

The Board found the applicant to be a fit and proper person and approved the application.

11:00 a.m. to 11:35 a.m., Case 5720, Application of Mark Jarema to replace Betty Boone on the existing Class B – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Betty Boone for the use of J&P Pizza Liberty Road, LLC, t/a VCP, 2600 W. Liberty Road, Westminster, in Election District 9.

The Board found the applicant to be a fit and proper person and approved the application with the condition that the outstanding tax issue with the State Comptroller be satisfied prior to the issuance of the liquor license.

One-day liquor license applications (2) for outdoor events: (Chili & Beer Festival) by the Community Foundation of Carroll County to be held at the Sandosky Parking Lot in Sykesville on September 8; and (Summer Football Festival) at the Ag Center on August 16 & 17, were presented and approved by the Board.
5. A letter and photos from Dario Gonzalez, of The Greene Turtle/Westminster, requesting permission for an outdoor event in the parking lot area on September 21, were presented and approved by the Board.
6. A letter from Stanley Windsor, of the Westminster Loyal Order of the Moose, requesting permission for an outdoor event (horseshoe tournament) on September 14, was presented and approved by the Board.

7. A letter from Scott Beck, of E.W. Beck's Pub, requesting permission to serve alcoholic beverages outdoors on September 8, was presented and approved by the Board.
8. A letter and drawing from Dave Johansson, of Johansson's, of proposed renovations to enclose his brewery room, were presented and approved by the Board.
9. Inspector Kaizer informed the Board of an organization (Maryland Beer Pong) that contacted him regarding Beer Pong Tournaments in the County. The Board referred to Rule #61 regarding Drinking Games that prohibits such events.
