

**BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

**On January 8, 2014, the Board of License Commissioners met in Room 003 of the Carroll County Office Building, 225 North Center Street, Westminster, Maryland 21157. Board members Roland Meerdter, Chairman, Robert Tabler and David Brauning were present as well as Assistant County Attorney Timothy Dixon, Counsel to the Board; and Jo Vance.**

**10:00 a.m. Case 5736, Class BC – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Aristidis Harry Sirinakis for the use of Mt. Olympus, Ltd., t/a Harry's Main Street Grille, 65 W. Main Street, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Sale to a Minor). The Board found a violation had occurred and issued a fine of \$300.00.**

**10:30 a.m. Case 5737, Class B – Beer and Light Wine License issued to Niel J. Borrelli for the use of Café Capuano, Inc., t/a Mediterraneo, 8 Westminster Shopping Center, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Sale to Minor). The Board found a violation had occurred and issued a fine of \$300.00.**

**11:00 a.m. Case 5738, Class A – Beer, Wine and Liquor License issued to Wayne A. Glover and Wayne A. Dyke for the use of Read's, Inc., t/a Rite Aid Liquors, #7 Westminster Shopping Center, Westminster – Violation Hearing (Sale to Minor). The Board found a violation had occurred and issued a fine of \$2,000.00.**

**12:10 p.m.,** the Board addressed the following official business:

2. Letter and drawings from Hampstead Pizza Hut with description of renovations/improvements to be made with Permit application to be completed, presented and approved by the Board.

4. Fax from Brick Ridge restaurant about their vacation closure from January 6 through January 16, 2014, presented and approved by the Board.
5. Fax from Rafael's with proposed deck party dates for 2014 for Board approval, presented and approved by the Board.
6. Tim Dixon reported that he is working on a document to satisfy the requirements of our Risk Management Department for ROTC cadets to work with Inspector Kaizer to age compliance checks in the County.
7. Dave Brauning reported that he had testified twice before the Carroll County Delegation regarding the proposed legislation to raise liquor license fees in Carroll County. He also reported that the Delegation encouraged the Board to work with the Carroll County Coalition Against Underage Drinking. The Coalition's next meeting will be held at the Carroll County Health Department on January 31, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. He also reported that the discussion of

the proposed legislation by the Delegation seemed favorable. The Carroll County Licensed Beverage Association also presented a proposed bill that would end the current mandate that Carroll County pay the municipalities 25% of the license fees collected. The Board was informed that the Delegation will meet this Friday, January 10, 2014, to vote on what bills will be submitted to the Legislature.
