**Environmental Awareness Awards** – Ms. Kim Petry will e-mail the members announcing the winners of this year’s awards and encouraged the Council to attend the Thursday, April 10, 2008 ceremony to be held at 11:15 a.m. in Room 311, if their schedule permits.

**Bruceville Road** – Ms. Cindy Parr gave the Council an update since the last meeting that the BOC have been briefed on the Bruceville Road situation, looking at it from a point of a declaratory ruling. Ms. Terri Jones, Esquire added the Zoning Administration has the ability to look at each day as a separate incident but State law caps the fine amount at up to \$500.00 per day per violation. The BZA will hear Mr. Mehring’s appeal on April 23, 2008 at 9:30 a.m., with some Bruceville Road residents testifying. Ms. Jones stated Mr. Mehring paid all outstanding fines. County staff will put together a declaratory ruling with criteria as to egregious offenses and repeat offenses so as to avoid claims of selective enforcement or arbitrary and capricious application. The ruling will be presented to the BOC for their review and/or approval.

**Cool Counties Committee** – Dan Andrews advised the Council he is beginning to collect information on recycling of CFLs and long tube lights. He found a website known as Partners in Planet Protection [www.4pipp.com](http://www.4pipp.com) where CFLs cost \$ 0.80 each to be shipped to New York for disposal.
