### Carroll County Farm Museum Presents 2012 Calendar of Events

Westminster, MD, January 13, 2012 – The 2012 Farm Museum Calendar of Events will be available January 19, 2012. These calendars can be picked up at the Museum office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. or we can mail them to your residence. Contact the Museum office at 410-386-3880.

The 140 acre facility opens to group tours beginning in April and run through the end of October, Tuesday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. May through October, the Museum opens on weekends from Noon until 5 p.m. During July & August the Museum opens to the public weekly Tuesday through Friday from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.

General admission for adults is \$5.00; ages 7-18 and 60+ is \$4.00; 6 and under are admitted free with paying adult. Admission for students and chaperones for school and group tours is \$4.00. Admission for Carroll County schools is \$3.00. One teacher per class is admitted free with school groups.

Rental opportunities include four pavilions, a Reception Barn, the George Grier Memorial Meeting Room, and various size tents. The Carroll County Farm Museum is the perfect retreat for picnics, weddings, meetings, and other gatherings.
