Notices of public hearings of alleged violations of state law and the Board's rules and regulations are governed by Article 2B, Section 10-403 of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rule 2 of the Board's rules and regulations. Section 10-403 requires at least ten days notice before hearings. Rule 2 specifies notice by certified mail or personal delivery. A hearing notice sign is not required to be posted and notices are not required to be published in newspapers.

<sup>1</sup> Filing deadline is approximately 40 days prior to hearing.

<sup>2</sup> Agenda is prepared approximately 30 days prior to the hearing.

<sup>3</sup> Normal practice is to publish notices the last two Fridays of the month before the next month's scheduled hearing.

<sup>4</sup> Notices of public hearings for new licenses or transfer of licenses are governed by provisions of Article 2B, Section 10-202 of the Annotated Code of Maryland. Although hearing notice signs are not required to be posted on the premises for new licenses or transfers of licenses, the practice is to post a sign coinciding with publication of the first hearing notice.
