GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Manages the overall direction, coordination, and evaluation of the Carroll County Regional Airport in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration, Maryland Aviation Administration, Federal, State, and local laws.

ESSENTIAL TASKS include the following; other duties may be assigned.

1. Perform supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the current Carroll County Personnel Ordinance, County policies and applicable laws
2. Formulate goals, policies, programs, procedures, and work schedules for the Airport
3. Consult legal counsel to ensure policies, procedures, and practices comply with Federal, State, and local laws
4. Develop, administer, and enforce the Airport's policies, procedures, and other documents
5. Prepare and manage operating and capital budgets for Airport Enterprise Fund in a self-supporting capacity by exercising supervisory authority over the fixed base operator(s) (FBO) for maximum operational efficiency
6. Manage and supervise the project planning, design, and construction to support the future needs of the Airport
7. Design, develop, and implement public relations marketing campaign through verbal and print media
8. Develop procedures for use in the event of aircraft accident, fire, or other emergency situations
9. Provide for the safe operation of the Airport with emphasis on compliance with FAA Regulations and Airport Guidelines and Directives
10. Prepare and negotiate contracts/leases with Airport tenants and manage terminal services
11. Collect data, analyze data and compile reports required by management and/or other governmental agencies
12. Address errors and complaints
13. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

1. Bachelor's degree in Airport Management, Professional Aeronautics, Public Administration, or related field
2. Five years experience in airport operations and extensive knowledge of FAA regulations
3. Prefer Accredited Airport Executive (AAE) certification by American Association of Airport Executives
