GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Perform mechanical repair, replacement and preventative maintenance of Class 2 wastewater collection generators for associated facilities and pump stations for the Bureau of Utilities in accordance with Federal, State, and local laws.

ESSENTIAL TASKS include the following; other duties may be assigned.

1. Troubleshoot and repair mechanical equipment, vacuum pump priming systems, liquid and dry chemical feeders, electrical equipment, electronic equipment, and hydraulic systems
2. Maintain the Bureau of Utilities emergency standby generators to ensure dependable operation during power outage situations including yearly preventative maintenance, diagnoses and repair as required, coordination with outside vendors for parts, warranty repairs and regular operational checks
3. Install and repair wastewater collection lines including flanged ductile iron, PVC, copper, galvanized pipe, and fittings
4. Assist in replacing or upgrading equipment, building maintenance, coordination with contractors and vendors for equipment repair
5. Perform electrical and mechanical maintenance of lines, facility equipment, pumps, and motors
6. Drive and operate the Jet / Vac truck
7. Maintain equipment and tools
8. Complete routine paperwork such as time sheets, logs, and reports
9. Report to work outside of normal work hours for emergency operations
10. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
11. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations
12. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals, and assuring appropriate follow-through and/or resolution

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

1. High school diploma or general education diploma (GED)
2. Five years of experience in diesel maintenance and repair, maintenance of industrial generators and wastewater collection pump stations equipment including centrifugal pumps, compressed air systems and hydraulic systems *
3. Knowledge of Jet / Vac truck operations and procedures preferred
4. Knowledge of electrical control systems preferred*

* A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualification.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS

1. Valid driver's license (Mechanic I)
2. Class A Commercial Driver's License (Mechanic II)
3. Department of Transportation (DOT) Card required
4. State of Maryland Wastewater Collection Class 2 Temporary Operator License required within 30 days of employment.
5. State of Maryland Wastewater Collection Class 2 Operator License required within 3 years of employment.
