GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Provides planning, design and preparation of plans, permits and documents for all aspects of roadway, storm drainage and stormwater management construction in accordance with Federal, State and local codes and regulations.

5. Assign, review and approve CADD projects. Provide direction and guidance to Engineering Technicians with respect to assigned projects.
6. Coordinate and review the acquisition of field survey data.
7. Summarize and provide project information, participate in work groups and attend public meetings
8. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
9. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations
10. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals, and assuring appropriate follow through and/or resolution
11. Communicate with managers, supervisors, co-workers, citizens, media, and others, maintains confidentiality; and represents the County.
