GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Operates equipment and vehicles to maintain County roads, bridges, and storm drains.

ESSENTIAL TASKS include the following; other duties may be assigned

1. Operate trucks and light road maintenance equipment
2. Maintain roads, bridges and storm drains
3. Perform debris and tree/brush trimming, and removal
4. Maintain equipment and tools
5. Maintain vehicles including completing vehicle inspection reports required by Department of Transportation
6. Perform duties of Road Maintenance Worker as assigned and needed
7. Report to work outside of normal work hours for emergency operations
8. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
9. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations.
10. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals and assuring appropriate follow-through and/or resolution

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

1. High School diploma or general education diploma (GED) preferred
2. One year equipment/vehicle operation related to road maintenance *
3. Requires passing Carroll County REO I equipment test within ninety days of employment

* A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualification.
