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**GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES** Operates and maintains wastewater collection systems and facilities for the County in accordance with Federal, State and local laws.

**ESSENTIAL TASKS** include the following; other duties may be assigned.

1. Check wastewater pumping stations and network for problems
2. Log flow and maintains charts
3. Perform electrical and mechanical maintenance of lines, facility equipment, pumps, and motors
4. Coordinate repair work with Miss Utility and outside contractors and perform flagging when needed
5. Maintain equipment and tools
6. Assist in conducting semi-final and final inspections of wastewater hook-ups and maintenance of right-of way
7. Complete routine paperwork such as time sheets, logs, and reports
8. Assist with Jet truck operations
9. Report to work outside of normal work hours for emergency operations
10. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
11. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations

### **EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**
