Provides technical review of plans and programs related to water resources for Carroll County in accordance with Federal, State and local laws, within the goals and objectives of the Bureau of Resource Management.

2. Prepare and maintain schedule, statistical tables, calibration records, reports and maps
3. Provide technical project expertise, participates in work groups and attends public meetings
4. Apply principles, practices, laws and regulations for planning, zoning, surveying, real estate and land development
5. Conduct field work and provide technical assistance for various water quality monitoring programs
6. Perform water resource inspections related to project implementation and TMDL (Total Maximum Daily Load) compliance
7. Work with Board of County Commissioners and state/local/municipal agencies in water resources issues and projects
8. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
9. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations
10. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals, and assuring appropriate follow-through and/or resolution
11. Communicate with managers, supervisors, co-workers, citizens, and others, maintains confidentiality, and represents the County
