

# BRIDGE INSPECTIONS

## DESCRIPTION

The National Bridge Inspection Program establishes the standards for inspection and evaluation of highway bridge structures. These inspections are required at least every two years. The inspection of the County's structures, including the Green Street bridge that is maintained by the City of Westminster, will be conducted this year. Overall, 133 major structures (those over twenty feet in length) and nineteen minor structures (under twenty feet in length) will be inspected this year.

The County's consultant will perform a thorough inspection of each structure, including the approach roadway and stream characteristics. The findings will be included in the inspection report for each structure.

The information obtained from these inspections is used to set maintenance schedules and to develop priorities for repairs and/or replacements in the Community Investment Program.

## UPDATES

### March 27, 2012:

The field work for the inspection program is complete. Reports for each structure have been submitted and are in review.

### May 1, 2011:

The inspections will be on-going between May and December 2011.
