

JOHN PICKETT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

DESCRIPTION

The John Pickett Road project involves minor geometric improvements, proper storm culverts and stormwater management design, and paving of this existing gravel road, from the existing paved section to Grimville Road. The project will be designed to meet all the current environmental criteria.

Funding for the project was approved in the FY 2015 Community Investment Program.

Once construction begins, local traffic will be maintained through the work area. There may be periods where traffic is detoured around the project site.

UPDATES

July 8, 2016:

The MD Department of the Environment authorizations for the pipe construction have been issued. Construction of these pipes and ancillary work are planned for this summer.

Stormwater management design is continuing.

May 31, 2016:

The design work is approximately 75% complete. A public information meeting was held on May 16, 2016. Dialog with the citizens was beneficial.

Permit applications have been sent to the MD Department of the Environment.
