

# LOW VOLUME ROAD OVERLAYS

## DESCRIPTION

This year, two County roads are included in the annual maintenance overlay program for lower volume roads. Drainage pipes, reclamation, pavement milling, hot mix asphalt paving, shoulders and traffic barrier are typical work items addressed with the project. Drainage pipe work will be completed under a separate contract. Maintaining our roads with a strong overlay program delays or eliminates the need for much more costly road reconstruction.

Once construction begins, traffic will be maintained through the work zone with flagging operations. Construction is expected to last about four months. Weekly press releases will identify the roadwork planned for the following week. The press releases will appear in the local newspaper and on the County's website.

Public Works thanks the public for their patience and understanding as this roadwork proceeds.

**May 21, 2009:**  
**Notice to proceed with the drainage pipe work was issued to the contractor on April 13. Work is ongoing.**

**Notice to proceed with the paving work was issued to the contractor on May 15. Benson Road paving has been completed.**

March 5, 2009:

Thirteen bids were opened for the drainage pipe repairs through a competitive bid process on February 11, 2009. Five bids were opened for the low volume paving project on February 25, 2009. The Commissioners concurred on awarding the drainage pipe project to Stambaugh, Inc. and the paving project to C. J. Miller, LLC. Contract award is underway.
