

Westminster High School Stormwater Management Facility

LOCATION

Westminster High School is located between Route 97 and Route 32 south of Hook Road. The high school is located within the Liberty Reservoir Watershed.

DESCRIPTION

Construction of a Westminster High School stormwater facility is a joint project between Carroll County Government and Carroll County Board of Education. The facility will be constructed to capture and treat the entire drainage area which is highly developed. The drainage area currently has minimal functioning stormwater management. The County was awarded \$453,526.00 from the State of Maryland Transportation Enhancement Program in May of 2009 to construct this facility which will ultimately treat untreated stormwater off of two state roads.

- Received state and federal permits.

September 2011

- The County has received all approvals from the Maryland State Highway Administration.
- Final plans were sent to MDE so that they permit could be issued. We are currently awaiting our permit.
