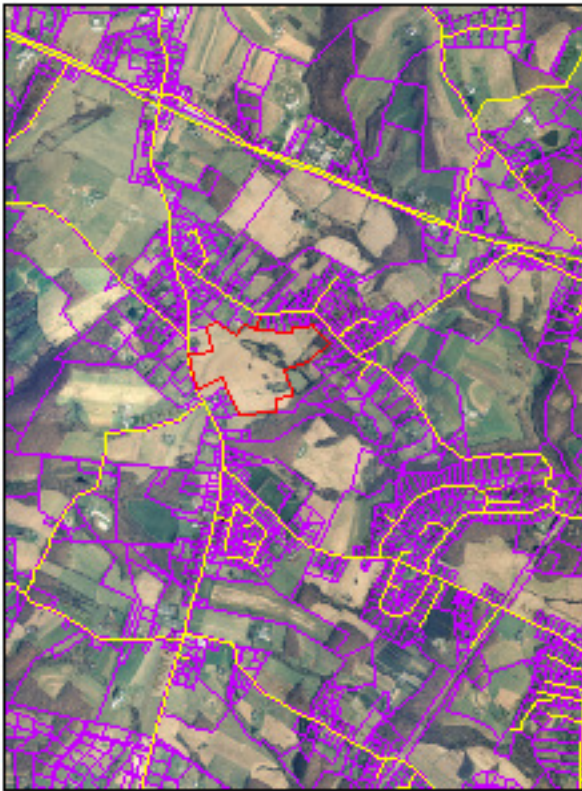
Krimgold Park

Project Summary

The Department of Recreation and Parks plans to create a new active regional park on 100 plus acres in the South Carroll area. The park will include ball fields, multi-purpose fields, pavilions, a playground, and a parking area with 200 spaces. The park will also offer opportunities for fishing, hiking, and walking activities. The Krimgold property, near Maryland Route 26 and Woodbine Road, will be the site for this new regional park. It is estimated by the Department of Recreation and Parks that annually there will be 30,000 individuals that will use the park.

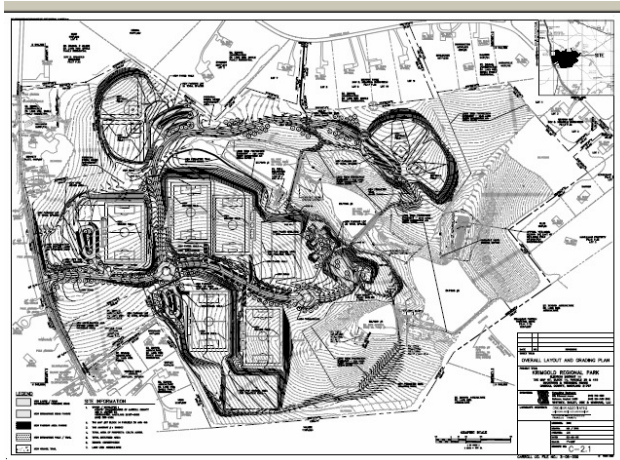
