

# MD 30 AND MAPLE GROVE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

## DESCRIPTION

This project involves improvements to MD 30 and Maple Grove Road that will provide efficient access to the Manchester Valley High School. This new high school is currently under construction by Carroll County Public Schools. MD 30 will be improved from St. Bartholomew's Church to Charmil Drive. Road widening and paving, lane use changes, traffic signal installation, and drainage improvements are planned.

Once construction begins, traffic will be maintained through the work area, however lane closures are expected. There may be times when night work will be permitted between the hours of 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM. Construction is expected to last about five months.

Completing this project will benefit the traveling public by providing a quality paved roadway and an efficient, safe intersection at Maple Grove Road.

## UPDATES

### January 8, 2010:

The construction work was completed in conjunction with the opening of the new Manchester Valley High School.

### May 21, 2009:

The majority of earthwork is complete. Installing storm drains and relocating utilities continues. The traffic signal work is scheduled to begin soon.

### March 9, 2009:

Notice to Proceed was issued to the contractor.

### January 29, 2009:

Seven bids were opened through a competitive bid process on January 21, 2009. The Commissioners concurred on awarding the project to C. J. Miller, LLC.

### October 2008:

Consultant addressing final details of the road and drainage design.

### July 2007:

Survey work and preliminary engineering started.
