

Surplus Equipment

The Carroll County Bureau of Purchasing maintains a surplus furniture and equipment warehouse. All furniture, fixtures, and equipment no longer required for use by County agencies are turned over to the Bureau of Purchasing to be warehoused. As needed, items are reissued to other County agencies, creating a cost avoidance.

From time to time Purchasing may determine that an item is no longer needed for government use. If the items have monetary value, they will be sent to Wolfe Industrial Auction to be sold on the County's behalf. This revenue is then returned to the County's general fund. Surplus cars, trucks, and maintenance equipment are also sent to Wolfe Industrial Auction. By law all auctions are advertised in a local paper.
