

Bennett Cerf Dog Park Rules

The rules listed below are for the protection of those who use this facility and are intended to maintain a safe, healthy and clean dog park

1. The dog park is open to paid members only. To become a member, visit www.bennettcerfdogpark.org or call 410-386-2103.
2. All dogs must be accompanied by an owner age 16 or older at all times. Limit of two dogs per adult.
3. **Dogs must be leashed when approaching and leaving the Dog Park.** Prong, spike or choke collars and retractable leashes are prohibited.
4. Dog's leashes should be removed when inside the double gated area. Collars, displaying the assigned dog park tag as well as rabies & County license tag should be displayed at all times.
5. Children ages 12-15 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult that will be accountable for the behavior and well-being of the child. **Children under 12 are not permitted in the park.**
6. Carroll County is not responsible for injuries to dogs, their owners/handlers, or others that use this Dog Park. Use Dog Park at own risk. This area is for dogs and their owners/handlers only.
7. Owners/handlers are legally responsible for their dog's behavior and any destruction caused by his/her dog. Any holes created by a dog shall be filled by the dog's owner.
8. Female dogs "in heat" (in estrus) and puppies under the age of 4 months are prohibited in the Dog Park at any time.
9. Dogs with a known history of aggressive or dangerous behavior and/or dogs that have displayed aggressive or dangerous behavior at this facility are prohibited.
10. All dogs must be healthy, currently vaccinated against rabies and legally licensed, with proof available on site.
11. **No eating or smoking allowed inside the Dog Park.** No dog treats or toys (except tennis balls) are allowed. Water may be brought in; however, glass containers are not allowed.
12. Owners are responsible for securely latching both control gates as they enter or exit.
13. Owners must remain in the off leash area with their dogs at all times and maintain sight of and voice command control of their dog.
14. Any dog showing aggression toward people or other dogs must be immediately leashed and removed from the Dog Park by its owner/handler.
15. Any dog barking continuously or uncontrollably must be removed from the Dog Park by the handler.
16. Owners/handlers must pick up and properly dispose of their dog's feces.
17. No commercial business may be conducted inside the Dog Park.
18. Violators of rules will be subject to removal from the park and suspension of membership privileges.
