

## PAVILION RENTAL INFORMATION AND FEES

All pavilions are available on a reservation only basis. For more information or to reserve a pavilion, please call the park office at 410-795-5165, Monday thru Friday 8 am - 4 pm.

### Pavilion Fees:

Large Pavilion:

#1 \$250/day

(holds up to 250 people)

Medium Pavilions:

#4, 5 & 6 \$200/day

(Hold up to 125 people)

Small Pavilions:

#2 & 3 \$150/day

(Hold up to 60 people)

Pavilion prices include 5 free vehicle passes for day of rental

## BOAT RENTAL INFORMATION AND FEES



### To rent a boat, you must:

- ✓ Be at least 18 years of age
- ✓ Leave a driver's license
- ✓ Provide a \$20 deposit per boat
- ✓ Read & sign the PRP boat rental agreement

### Important Information:

- ✓ No child under the age of 4 is allowed in PRP rental boats
- ✓ All occupants MUST have a Personal Flotation Device (provided at boathouse)
- ✓ All occupants ages 12 and under AND those who cannot swim, MUST wear the PFD at all times
- ✓ At least one occupant must be at least 16 years of age

### Fees:

Canoes/Kayaks/Rowboats: \$10/hour  
Daily Fee \$35/day

Pedal Boats: \$10/half hour  
(No daily fee available for pedal boats)

## PINEY RUN PARK 2018 PARK ENTRANCE FEES

### OPEN SEASON

The Open Season runs March 1 thru November 30 each year. Entrance fees are collected at the gatehouse 7 days a week, 7 am until sunset. The Park is closed sunset to 7 am and no trespassing is allowed; this includes patrons entering park on foot.

### CARROLL COUNTY RESIDENTS

Daily Entrance fee: \$5/vehicle  
Season Pass: \$50/vehicle  
Additional Pass: \$20/vehicle  
Bus: \$35/bus

### OUT-OF-COUNTY RESIDENTS

Daily Entrance fee: \$10/vehicle  
Season Pass: \$75/vehicle  
Additional Pass: \$20/vehicle  
Bus: \$70/bus

### \*BOAT LAUNCH FEES

(regardless of county of residence)

Daily Boat Launch: \$8/boat  
Season Pass: \$50/boat  
Additional Pass (2 max): \$20/boat

\*These fees include kayaks and canoes  
\*\*All private boats MUST be off the lake 1/2 hour prior to park closing. Please check in at gatehouse or boat ramps for exact time upon entry into the Park.

No entrance fees are collected during our “Closed Season” which runs December 1 thru February 28 each year. The gates are open Monday thru Friday 8 am until 4 pm and closed on the weekends during the Closed Season.

The Piney Run Nature Center is an interpretive facility of the Carroll County Department of Recreation and Parks, located within Piney Run Park. Nature Center admission is free and naturalists are available to answer questions and share nature's surprises.
