

TOURNAMENTS & LATE-NIGHT FISHING

Piney Run Park has various fishing tournaments throughout the open season from March-November. The park offers various tournaments that are either species specific or that are multiple species. Cash prizes are awarded at all tournaments except the Youth Panfish Derby where various kid's prizes are awarded to winners. Every tournament also has a trophy given to the overall biggest fish.

Piney Run also has Late Night Fishing (non-tournaments) the 1st Friday of every month throughout the season. The park will be open to fisherman until midnight on those evenings.

Note: Only during late night fishing events and tournaments is it legal to be in the park after sunset.



Fish Species of Piney Run Lake:

- * Black Crappie (creel limit 15)
- * Blue Gill & Sunfish (creel limit 15)
- * Yellow Perch (9" min. size, creel limit 10)
- * Rainbow Trout (creel limit 5)
- * Bullhead & Channel Catfish (creel limit 5)
- * Small & Large Mouth Bass (season closed March 1st—June 15th, 12" min. size, creel limit 5)
- * Striped Bass (18" min. size - only 1 may be over 30", creel limit 2)
- * Tiger Muskie (36" min. size, creel limit 1)



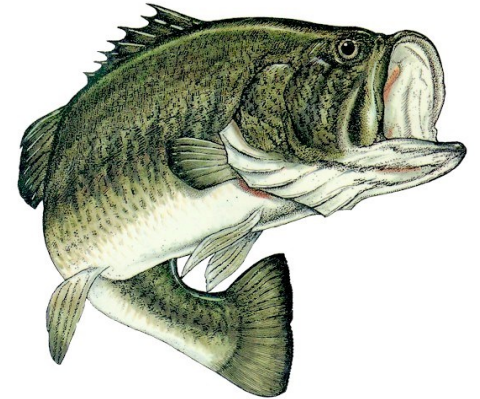
Piney Run Park Fishing Structure Map

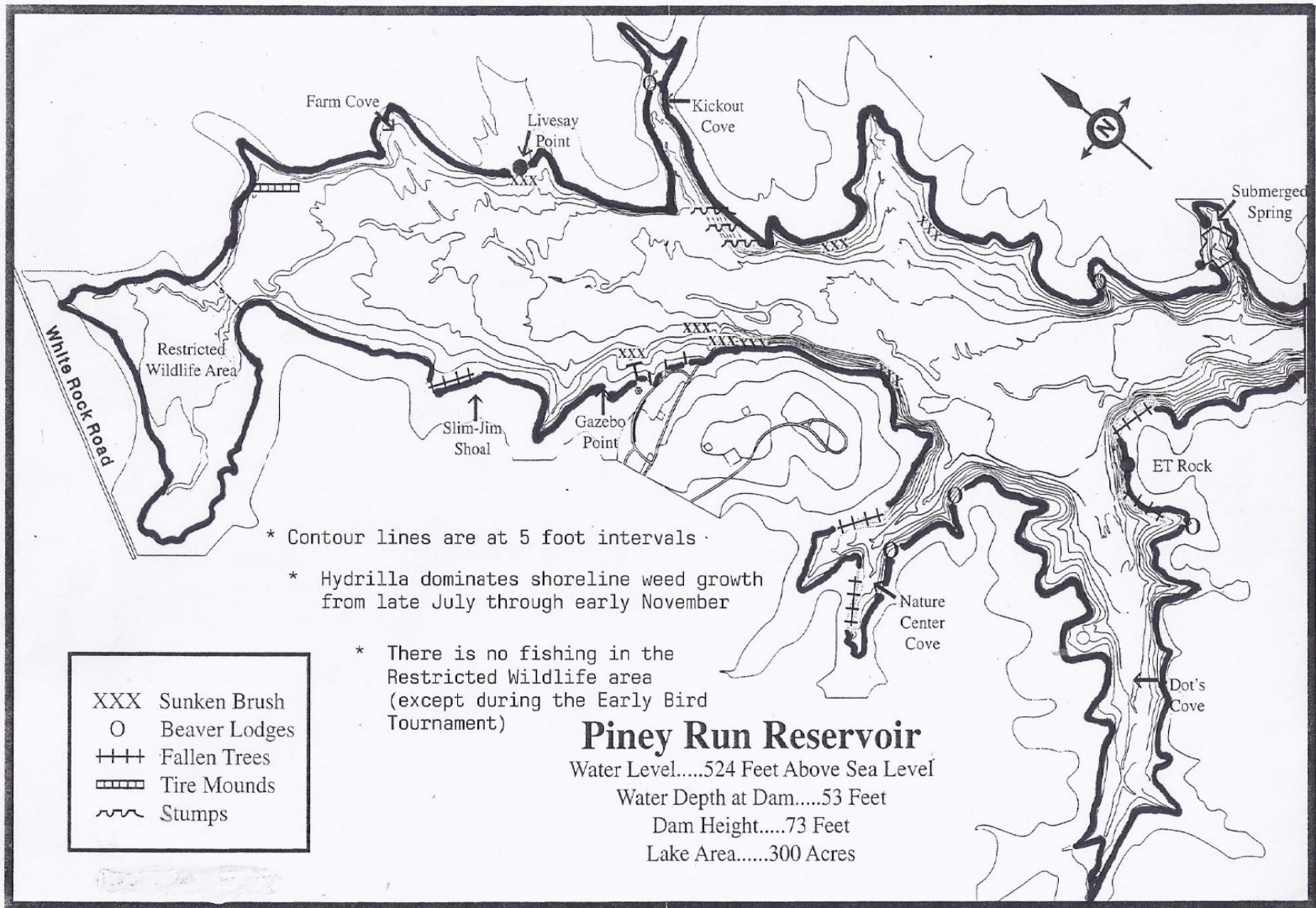
