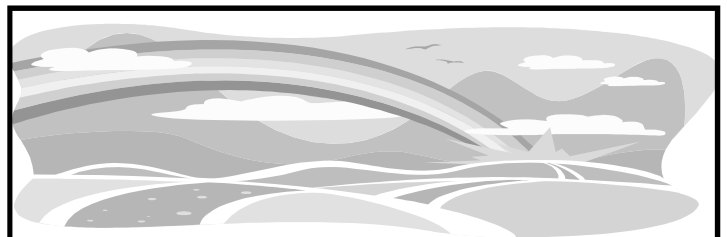
# BOATING
