

- ▶▶ Aluminum & bi-metal cans, clean aluminum foil items, aerosol cans, (**empty only**)
- ▶▶ Plastic narrow neck containers & jugs #1 thru #7 only, (**no motor oil or transmission fluid bottles**) wide mouth plastic containers such as yogurt and cottage cheese. Lids and caps can stay on containers.
- ▶▶ Food & beverage glass jars & bottles, all colors, not broken
- ▶▶ Paper - newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, paperback, hardback & telephone books, flattened corrugated & light cardboard, paper bags, non-metallic wrapping paper, office paper, computer printouts, carbonless paper, paper shredded due to security reasons, milk and juice containers, including gable top and aseptic containers.

Sorry, we cannot accept for recycling:

- ✗ Wax coated paper or boxes
- ✗ Paper and cardboard with plastic, wax or metal laminates
- ✗ Papers contaminated by food, animal waste, grease or oils
- ✗ Carbon paper
- ✗ Paper with any trace of hazardous, medical or chemical residues
- ✗ Paper loads with total moisture content exceeding 12%
- ✗ Blueprints or white prints (due to chemical residue)
- ✗ Heavily colored papers with water soluble inks
- ✗ Items that once held petroleum products

MULCH PROGRAM

Mulch is available throughout the year and is free to County residents only. This mulch is a natural wood product and may contain allergens, poison ivy/oak, termites, and/or carpenter ants. Curing in compost may eliminate many of these problems. Not recommended for new plants, new shrubbery or new trees. **Call for availability.** Come prepared to self-load mulch and wear proper clothing as needed (long- sleeve shirt and pants, gloves, eye protection and dust mask). No charge to residents, limit one pick up truck load or three cubic yards per trip. Larger quantities charged as commercial \$2/cubic yard. Commercial customers, \$2/cubic yard.

Goodwill®

Goodwill® offers residents a full donation center. Goodwill® donations will be screened and sorted. Items that are in good used condition will be offered for sale at one of their retail stores. Staff will also be available to give receipts for donated items. **Goodwill® cannot accept:** Broken, torn, stained, odorous furniture, Hazardous material, Framing supplies, Appliances.

ReStore

ReStore accepts unused building materials and appliances to raise funds to build more Habitat homes for hardworking families in need. **They do not accept:** Unframed mirrors or glass, Lumber, plywood, siding, or trim under 4ft. long, Used or opened paint, Used carpet, Building materials with nails or screws, Gas stoves.

The following items *cannot* be accepted:

- ✗ Explosive/combustible materials
- ✗ Pathological/infectious or other medical wastes
- ✗ Radioactive and other hazardous wastes
- ✗ Electric arc furnace dust
- ✗ "Free liquids"
- ✗ Sludges and similar residual wastes
- ✗ Tree stumps
- ✗ Logs & brush greater than 4" in diameter & 8' in length
- ✗ Hot ashes or any material that shows evidence of smoking, smoldering, burning
- ✗ Concrete slabs/curbing, brick bats, stone or similar materials greater than 6" in dimension
- ✗ Automobile parts, (complete bodies, frames, engine blocks & transmissions)
- ✗ Sealed drums, closed large containers and tanks
- ✗ Large slabs of iron, steel and other intact bulky wastes, which may be considered potentially detrimental to landfill equipment
- ✗ Pipe over 4' in length or 4" in diameter
- ✗ Dead animals

Out-of-County contractors, doing work within the County, may obtain a temporary landfill permit upon request at the Northern Landfill. The permits are restricted to 1 month or less; a vehicle registration card and information relevant to the job site is necessary.

Northern Landfill is available to Carroll County residents only.

In addition to traditional household wastes generated in Carroll County, Northern Landfill accepts:

- ✓ Concrete/asphalt smaller than 6" in diameter-fee
- ✓ Fluorescent bulbs & tubes (wrap in paper and place in plastic bag) - **fee**
- ✓ Latex paint cans-residue paint must be hardened or dry - **fee**
- ✓ Rotted railroad ties, wooden skids & remodeling debris - **fee**
- ✓ Tires – 5 per year/per household @ \$1.50/each (off rim), \$2.50/each (on rim), 33" limit (over 5 tires requires a State hauling license. Commercial Load, \$140.00/ton. For information go to: www.dsd.state.md.us/comar/26/26.04.08.04.htm
- ✓ White goods – scrap metal, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, air conditioners, freezers & refrigerators, etc. (doors must be removed) -**no charge**
- ✓ Yard trim - leaves, grass, shrubs & tree trimmings (limited to 8' in length & 4" in diameter) - **must be brought in paper lawn bags or loose. Plastic bags prohibited in this area. No charge** to residents-commercial/businesses \$20/ton

RECYCLING CENTER - *No Charge*

410-386-4556 - residential use only in marked areas:

⇒ Electronics – computer items: monitors, non-wooden speakers, CPUs, mice, keyboards, printers, power supplies, cables & cords, laptops, scanners, circuit boards, chips & cards. Also accepted are televisions (**no consoles or rear projection**), cell phones & PDAs.

⇒ Plastics-rigid plastics, grocery and empty clear food bags, plastic film, CD/DVD cases and discs

⇒ Textiles – Includes clean, dry & odor free clothes, linens, drapes, hats, paired shoes & socks, etc., in clear plastic bag.

⇒ Car batteries

⇒ Up to 5 gallons/week/resident of used motor oil & antifreeze

⇒ Kitchen oil/Grease

⇒ Vinyl Siding

⇒ Styrofoam -Clean only foam food service containers, including foam cups, plates, take-out containers, egg cartons, as well as shaped or molded foam often used to package electronics. **No:** Foam packaging peanuts (accepted at many retail shipping outlets), Straws, lids, tape or stickers, Foam Insulation material, Clamshell or non-foam #6 containers

⇒ Aluminum beverage cans (reimbursement between 9 a.m.-3 p.m. Monday-Friday & 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Saturday – reimbursement fluctuates with the market value)

**NOTE: Used motor oil & antifreeze may be dropped off at the Town Maintenance Garages in Hampstead & Sykesville. Used motor oil may be dropped off at Westminster's Public Works Facility, Town of Manchester Garage & Taneytown Memorial Park.*

SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING

Items no longer need to be sorted; place the following together in the designated drop-off area at the Recycling Center. Rinsed containers are preferred.
