Carroll County Emergency Management Asks Business Owners and Residents with Damages from the January Winter Storm to Provide Information

Westminster, Monday, February 1, 2016 – Carroll County Emergency Management is encouraging residents and businesses affected by the historic snowstorm, which began January 22, 2016, to contact their office with information on the type and extent of loss they experienced as a direct result of the weather event, including losses in business revenue due to closures. This information will be used to determine areas around the state that may require assistance in the recovery process.

Carroll County Director of Economic Development Jack Lyburn added, “Carroll County businesses are resilient, but there are times when Mother Nature gets the upper hand. The Blizzard of 2016 is one of those times that hampered business as usual; it is great that there may be business assistance to help recover from losses due to this historic storm.”
