Help Needed to Identify Dog

Westminster, Wednesday, April 20, 2016 – The Carroll County Health Department is asking area residents for help in finding a dog that bit a person sometime between 5:30 pm and 6:00 pm at the Taneytown Skatepark on Roberts Mill Road in Taneytown on Sunday, April 17th. The dog is described as having a medium sized build, a long straight white coat with brown spots, floppy ears, and straight medium length tail. According to the Health Department, it is likely the victim of the attack will be treated with a series of post-exposure rabies shots if the dog has not been found and verified to be in good health by the morning of April 27th.
