Big Fish Contest Winner Announced

Carroll County Department of Recreation and Parks and Piney Run Park recently named Steve Lenker of Catonsville, Maryland as the winner of the 2015 Big Fish Contest. This new contest was open to anglers at Piney Run Park who caught the largest fish during the April 1 – October 31, 2015 operating season.

Mr. Lenker rose to the top of the leader board by catching a striped bass weighing 15.9 pounds that measured 32 1/8 inches long on April 25. No one else caught a larger fish the rest of the year and as a result, The Board of County Commissioners along with the Director of Recreation and Parks, Jeff Degitz and Piney Run Park Superintendent, Sandy Buterbaugh presented Mr. Lenker with a check for \$500 and a free park vehicle pass for 2016 along with an opportunity to defend his title next year.
