Recreation and Parks Launches Helping Hands Campaign

Carroll County Department of Recreation and Parks has launched a campaign to encourage additional community involvement to help keep county parks clean. The Helping Hands Keep Parks Green initiative is modeled after similar efforts such as Adopt-A-Road and is designed to promote local ownership and care of parks.

Recreation and Parks Director Jeff Degitz noted that "Volunteer recreation councils already perform countless hours of maintenance supplementing County efforts, much of it related to athletic fields. The Helping Hands campaign is focused more on general park cleanliness, trash pickup and trail maintenance. It is an excellent opportunity for local groups to help keep their local parks beautiful"

Ebenezer United Methodist Church in Woodbine has been performing monthly clean up days at Krimgold Park for over a year and is the first group to be recognized through this program. A sign will be placed at the park acknowledging their efforts and thanking them for the ongoing commitment.
