Piney Run Park hosts 27th annual Apple Festival

August 14, 2010 – Celebrate the fall harvest at Piney Run Park’s 27th annual Apple Festival on Saturday, Sept. 25. This annual event, which runs from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., features a variety of activities, including games and hayrides, homemade foods such as apple dumplings, pies and fritters, freshly pressed apple cider, and craft and folk art vendors. Activities at this year’s festival include live music, face-painting, wagon rides, games and crafts, scarecrow stuffing, pumpkin painting, and face painting.

There is no festival entrance fee, although some activities at the festival may require tickets purchased at Piney Run. The standard park entry fee of \$5 for Carroll County residents’ vehicles and \$10 for all other vehicles will apply. No pets are allowed in the festival area.
