Reorganization of Citizen Services

Westminster, Monday, July 11, 2016 - The Department of Citizen Services has strategically re-aligned their leadership team by moving to a one Director and two Bureau Chief structure to ensure quality of service.

The Board of County Commissioners is pleased to announce the hiring of Ms. Celene Steckel, as the new Bureau Chief of Aging and Disabilities. She will assume this role on July 14, 2016.

Ms. Steckel has worked in the Aging & Disabilities field for over 20 years including 17 years in the public sector. Ms. Steckel has had the opportunity to work for Pennsylvania State Government's Office of Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services as well as for 2 local governments in Maryland; Howard County's Office on Aging and Carroll County's Bureau of Aging & Disabilities. Ms. Steckel has a strong management background which was further developed in her most recent position with Carroll County as the Health Benefits and Compensation Manager.
