**2016 Notice of Funding Availability
Continuum of Care Programs for the Homeless**

In response to HUD's release of the Continuum of Care (CoC) application, the Carroll County Circle of Caring Homelessness Board is inviting applications from new or existing CoC agencies to provide housing for homeless populations in Carroll County, Maryland. Agencies may apply for the renewal of existing CoC projects or may propose new permanent supportive housing or rapid re-housing programs. Applicants must show a proven history of successful management of programs for the homeless and demonstrate the capacity to provide or arrange for services for homeless populations.

The CoC's rating and ranking criteria will be sent to all applicants. A draft PDF of all project applications are due to the Carroll County Grants Office via email at ccgrants@ccg.carr.org by August 10, 2016. The Carroll County Circle of Caring will notify all applicants no later than August 30, 2016 if their project application is accepted or denied. Project applications selected by the Carroll County Circle of Caring Homelessness Board will be submitted as part of the Consolidated Continuum of Care Application to HUD. Final projects applications are due via E-snaps by September 2, 2016.
