County Hires Bureau Chief of Facilities

Westminster, Friday, June 3, 2016 – The Carroll County Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce the hiring of Mr. Doug Lindsay, as the Bureau Chief of Facilities for Carroll County. He assumed this role on May 19, 2016.

Mr. Lindsay has worked in the facilities management and construction industry for over 21 years. He began his career with Citicorp North America as the Assistant Vice President of Facilities. In this role he managed 26 buildings with a \$9M capital budget. Most recently he served as the Plant Operation's Engineer at Yuma Regional Medical Center in Yuma, AZ. While there he was responsible for the operations and management of the 500,000 square foot hospital, including the construction of 8 state of the art operating rooms and a 500 space parking garage.

In 2005, he received a US Army Third Infantry Division Recognition award for his time served in Iraq.
