BRIDGES TO BE CLOSED FOR ROUTINE BRIDGE INSPECTION: KEYSVILLE ROAD OVER TOMS CREEK, SIXES BRIDGE ROAD OVER MONOCACY RIVER, AND BULLFROG ROAD OVER MONOCACY RIVER

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Office of Transportation Engineering announced today that Keysville Road over Toms Creek, Sixes Bridge Road over the Monocacy River and Bullfrog Road over the Monocacy River will be temporarily closed at the Truss Bridges. This will allow the consultant, Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., to complete routine inspection work on the bridges. The closures will start on or about Thursday December 17, 2015 and continue through December 18, 2015, weather permitting, between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Only one bridge will be closed at a time with a detour in place.

For the Keysville Road bridge closure, a signed detour route using Four Points Road, Sixes Bridge Rd, Grimes Road, Sixes Road and Keysville Road will be in place during the bridge closure.

For the Sixes Bridge Road bridge closure, a signed detour route using Sixes Road, Grimes Road East, Keysville Road, Keysville Frederick Co. Road, Keysville Road South and Sixes Bridge Road will be in place during the bridge closure.

For the Bullfrog Road bridge closure, a signed detour route using Bollinger School Road, Taneytown Pike and Bullfrog Road will be in place during the bridge closure.

Department staff has notified emergency personnel and school agencies.
