## **Gaming Event Permit Application Now Available**

Westminster, Friday, August 7, 2015 – During the 2015 legislative session the Maryland General Assembly passed legislation allowing Carroll County non-profit organizations to begin hosting Game Night Fundraising Events as of October 1, 2015. These events may include card games, card tournaments and casino events.

Under the legislation, the county was required to create an application and permitting process. The process is in place and the applications are now available on line or in person.
