Westminster, MD, Friday, February 12, 2016 – The Bureau of Aging & Disabilities recently established the Carroll County Hoarding Taskforce and is conducting a survey to identify how extensive hoarding is in Carroll County and to identify needs of individuals with hoarding behaviors.

The goals of the Taskforce are to connect individuals with hoarding behaviors with resources and supports, and to assist them to safely remain in their homes. The Taskforce is comprised of government agency representatives, mental health providers, professional organizers, animal control professionals and others.
