Commissioners to Create Long Term Advisory Council

Westminster, MD, June 6, 2016 – The Board of County Commissioner's decided unanimously to create a Long Term Advisory Council in open session on May 31, 2016. This council would be tasked with looking at Carroll County and planning for its future. The council was proposed by Commissioner Doug Howard and would be a board authorized group consisting of 15 voting members from education, government, and law enforcement. Not all members would be government affiliated. There would be five representing each district, an individual from the Planning and Zoning Commission, a member of the Economic Development Commission, and lastly a representative of the local realtors association.

This council's meetings will be open to the public. They would have no decision making authority but would collect information, identify trends, and assemble long term recommendations to go before the Board of Carroll County Commissioners.

The council will be filled in the same manner as many of the county boards and commissions. There will be an application process and the applications are available on the [county's website](#). The Board of Carroll County Commissioners will then appoint the members to the Long Term Advisory Council after the application process has been closed. More information will be available in the coming weeks so check the county website for updates.
