## 2015 Hampstead Lions Club Little League Parade

**Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016 from 9 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.**

Normal traffic flow through the Town of Hampstead will be stopped beginning at about 0850 hrs and remained closed until the parade reaches Hillcrest Ave. Traffic will not be allowed on Main Street between Lower Beckleysville Rd and Rt. 482. The detour route provided should only add a few minutes to the normal time it takes to travel through Hampstead. The inconvenience of the parade will be minimal due to the shortness of the parade (approximately 30 minutes).

### Detour Route

S/B traffic on Rt. 30 will be directed to W/B Rt. 482 and Panther Drive where traffic will go S/B on Panther then cross over to Willow Street to Houcksville Road then to S/B Rt. 30.

N/B traffic on Rt. 30 will be directed to Houcksville Road to Willow Street the cross to N/B Panther Drive then to E/B Rt. 482 where they can continue N/B on Rt. 30.

The Route 30 By-Pass is always a viable option.

### Parade Route

- The parade will start at 0900 hrs from the Parking lot of Snyder's Auction on Mott Ave.
- The parade will take Mott Ave to N/B Main Street (Maryland Route 30) to Hillcrest Street.
- The parade will turn east and proceed on Hillcrest Avenue to Summit Avenue. Once the last participants have reached Hillcrest Avenue, Main Street may be re-opened to traffic.
- Finally, the parade will turn south into Lions Club Park, which is the termination point of the parade.
