FR Conversions Job Fair Announced

Westminster, MD – September 2, 2015 - FR Conversions, a new Carroll County company moving from Woodlawn to 1231 Tech Court in Westminster, will be holding a job fair on September 9th and 10th at the Carroll County Business & Employment Resource Center, located at 224 North Center Street, Westminster, from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

FR Conversions has been making mobility affordable since 2009, specializing in low cost, simple-to-use vehicles with rear entry conversion. Recently they have expanded their vehicle options to include full size transit/paratransit vehicles. Mobility vans are constructed on the Chryslers platforms (2008 model and newer), and the Toyota Sienna model (2011 and newer). Depending on the vehicle, modifications are available in both a long cut (full cut), that accommodates two wheelchairs, or taxi cut (half cut), that accommodates one wheelchair.

FR Conversions Chief Operations Officer Chris Mayfield said “The company is looking to hire experienced Mig welders, Automotive Tear Down personnel (vehicle interior disassembly), Automotive Finishers (vehicle interior installation), and a Custodian. The shift work runs from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Potential applicants will have a brief screening interview and if selected to go through to the next phase - an on-site job preview session. Welders will have an on-site welding test and all potential applicants will go through pre-employment drug screening.”
